



Denton Benefit League Grant Assists the Boys & Girls Clubs of Denton County

Donation to purchase copier November 2008

The members of the Denton Benefit have awarded a grant to the Boys and Girls Clubs of Denton County for the acquisition of a multi-functioning copier. The copier provides the availability of various printing features that greatly reduces the cost of using other outside printing resources.

“The Boys and Girls Clubs of Denton County are very pleased that the Denton Benefit League provided the Club this grant”, stated Babs Troutman, Chief Professional Officer. “Because of our nonprofit status, we have to print a variety of different business forms, donation marketing materials and other printed materials. The grant provided by the Denton Benefit League will allow us to provide a professional image at a greatly reduced cost”, Troutman said. The Club purchased the copier in 2007 with the help of business loan from a local banking establishment and the Denton Benefit League grant will be used to payoff the existing loan.

About the Denton Benefit League

In 1973 Denton Benefit League was founded by a group of women dedicated to improving the quality of life in the local Denton, Texas and the surrounding Denton County community north of Lake Lewisville. The Denton Benefit League has since grown to almost 300 members, all of whom are active volunteers in local organizations.

The Denton Benefit League's membership reflects the diversity of our community, as local people supporting local agencies and is nonpolitical, nonsectarian, and nonprofit in all its policies and activities. For over 36 years, the Denton Benefit League has provided active volunteers to numerous local organizations, through both individual effort and Denton Benefit League group projects. Over 568,000 volunteer hours have been contributed by Denton Benefit League members since its inception.

To date, Denton Benefit League has given the community almost \$3.1 million in funding to support nonprofit programs in social service and education, as well as historic and arts projects. One hundred percent of net proceeds are distributed to the community through the Project Research Grants program. NO contributions to the Denton Benefit League are used in our administration.

All Denton Benefit League expenses are supported by member dues. The Denton Benefit League has no paid staff and all work is performed by volunteers. Grant recipients are local nonprofit organizations supporting local needs and projects. Over 165 local organizations have received Denton Benefit League grants.
